A reading list of texts, books and articles has been compiled by the Curatorial Team at Chisenhale Gallery in collaboration with Banu Cennetoğlu to accompany her exhibition at Chisenhale. Included are books exploring ideas of visibility, perception, and the politics of memory in the context of sociology, art history, political and cultural theory and literature.
